

# Identifying Land Parcel Location by Using Mapsheet or Aerial Photo Mapsheet



## Processes and Procedures

### 1. Verifying Document.



(30 minutes)

Applicant, who requests for identifying land parcel location by using mapsheet or aerial photo mapsheet, lodges document as evidence by attaching to application form.



### 2. Consideration



(1 day)

Official verifies, prepares, and gives document of clarification, also, verifies and identifies mapsheet or aerial photo mapsheet.



## Attached Evidence

- (1) Land ownership certificate such as claim certificate (S.K.1), squatter certificate, certificate of utilization, N.K. 3, KSN. 5 and so on.
- (2) Natural Person: identification card, household registration and other evidences (if any) such as power of attorney and so on.
- (3) Copy of title deed or certificate of utilization (N.S. 3K) of vicinity area.
